


# **ACCOMMODATION REQUESTS**

Less than half (46%) of disability resource (DR) professionals reported that accommodation requests remained the same for students previously enrolled in DR services following the transition to online instruction



### STUDENT REACH OUT

More than half (55%) of DR directors noted difficulty communicating with students not currently registered with the DR office who may need additional support



### **INCLUSIVE COURSE DESIGN**

Over two-thirds (72%) of ADA coordinators noted difficulty communicating with faculty related to inclusive course design




## **EQUIPMENT ACCESS**

DR professionals employed at public two-year institutions (73%) reported more difficulty accessing needed equipment and devices for remote operating procedures than their counterparts at public four-year institutions (55%)



### **E-MAIL USE**

Nearly all participants (98%) noted individual emails as the top strategy for communicating with students and faculty during the transition to online instruction during the spring 2020 semester
