


Slide Annotations Walkthrough



This guide explains the different tools and how to use them to annotate your slides.

Settings and Multiple Upload



Left Panel: Scroll through your slide deck and post new slides to your notes feed

Zoom Settings: Make your slides bigger or smaller on screen


Search: Find key words and phrases across your original documents

Multiple Upload: Add additional slides and PDF documents to your event

Full Screen: View slides in full screen mode

Menu: Switch between View and Annotate modes, plus replace, delete, download or print slides

Annotate



Select: Pick an annotation to adjust the colour or delete it

Pan: Move the slide around to view annotations at high zoom levels

Free Text: Adds your own text to the slide

Text Format: Add underline, squiggly underline and strikethrough

Highlight: Add background highlight to any text

Free Hand: Add scribbles and drawings to your slides

Free Hand Highlight: Add highlighting anywhere on your slide

Shapes: Add various shapes (see below)

Color Picker: Change the color of your annotations

Erase, Undo & Redo: Delete any mistakes in your annotations

Shapes



Rectangle: Click and drag to draw a rectangle

Oval/Circle: Click and drag to draw an oval, hold SHIFT to draw a perfect circle

Line: Click and drag to draw line, hold SHIFT to create horizontal, vertical or diagonal lines

Arrow: Click and drag to draw an arrow

Cloud: Click to draw multiple cloud lines, then click the start point to create a cloud.

Arc: Click 3 times to draw an arc

Polygon: Click to create connected lines, then click the start point to create a shape

Polyline: Click to draw multiple connected lines, double click the end point to finish
